Bids are invited on the e-procurement platform from the Only manufacturers who have quality certification or direct importers only to enter into a Rate Contract (R.C) for 2019-21 for supply of surgical consumables to all the Central Medicines Stores (13) located in all the District Head Quarters in the State of A.P. The details of bidding conditions and other terms can be downloaded from the electronic procurement platform of Government of Andhra Pradesh i.e. https://tender.apeprocurement.gov.in

Bidders would be required to register on the e-procurement market place "www.apeprocurement.gov.in" and submit their bids online.

- 1. The bidders should have a minimum annual turnover during last three financial years (2015-16, 2016-17 and 2017-18) of Rs.2 crore for each year for MSMEs of A.P. and not less than Rs. 5 Crores for all the other bidders, in each year. The evidence of Turnover should be supported by a certificate from a Chartered Account.
- 2. The Bidder who participates in the tender should upload the following scanned Certificates/documents Online.
- i) PROCESSING FEE: The bidder shall remit processing fee Rs 5,625/-on line to the account of Managing Director, APMSIDC, Mangalgiri (Account No 142410011000314 IFSC code: ANDB0000366) and upload the original transaction slip with UTR number. Failure to pay the processing fee and submitting the slip in the aforesaid manner will lead to rejection of the bid
- **ii)** Valid manufacturing license/Licenses for manufacturing the products issued by concerned authorities.
- iii) Valid import license if the product is imported.(Under Form 10 in case of items notified as drugs)Valid Product license (For items notified as Drugs it is from DCA/DCG(I) and for Non Drug items it is from concerned statutory Departments).

- iv) Annual turnover certificate (Consolidated report) issued by a Chartered Accountant.
- v) The Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)/ Bank Gaurentee is for Rs.3,00,000/-in online in favour of Managing Director, APMSIDC, Mangalagiri, Guntur district.
- vi) a) Non Conviction Certificate (NCC) stating that the firm has not been convicted during the last 3 years issued on or after 01.04.2019 by DCA should be submitted for products notified as drugs.
  - **b)** NCC shall contain the Drug License number in case of drug related products and GST license number for other items.
  - c) NCC certified by Charted Accountant for non drug products.
- **vii)** Notarized affidavit on Rs.100/- Non-Judicial Stamp paper should be submitted for the gap period from the date of issue of NCC to bid submission date, given by the Proprietor/Managing Partner/ Managing director/ Director who is authorized by the board of directors as per the existing provisions of the companies act of the bidding firm stating that their firm has not been convicted during the period from the date of issue of NCC to the date of bid uploading and will submit the certificate to that effect from the concerned issuing authority in case their firm qualifies in the bid and enters into agreement with the corporation for supply of products on rate contract.
- vii) Scanned copy of Notarized affidavit on Rs.100/- Non-Judicial Stamp paper given by the Proprietor/Managing Partner/ Managing director/ Director who is authorized by the board of directors as per the existing provisions of the companies act of the bidding firm stating that their firm/bided products has not been blacklisted by any procuring agency in the country in terms of quality issues and submission of fabricated/forged documents/default supplies. If the declaration is proved to as false the firm shall pay Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh only) as penalty to APMSIDC in addition to legal action for cheating/misleading the corporation. If stood L1 and the firm or any product of the firm is blacklisted by any of the other procurement agencies during the period of rate of contract, the same shall be intimated to APMSIDC immediately failing which the penal actions mentioned in this paragraph shall be binding.
- viii) Scanned copy of a notarized affidavit on Rs.100/ -non judicial stamp paper given by the proprietor /managing partner / managing director / director who is

authorized by the board of directors of the company as per the existing provisions of the companies act stating that "Any document submitted by the firm for the tender ,if found to be Forged / Fabricated/ Erroneous / False , the Firm will be liable for blacklisting along with forfeiture of EMD. If the firm is exempted from EMD the amount equivalent to the same will be paid by the firm as penalty to APMSIDC, in addition to this the APMSIDC can initiate legal action as per law".

a) Valid GMP certificate as per the provisions of Schedule "M" issued by the concerned D.C.A. and for importers WHO GMP certificate or a certificate which is on par with the provisions of WHO GMP issued by the concerned licensing authority of the imported country in case of products notified as drugs. The certificate should be valid as on the date of participating in the bid. (If GMP / WHO GMP validity period is not mentioned in the certificate, it is treated as one year validity for GMP and 2 years validity for WHO GMP from the date of issue of certificate).

**b)** For Non drug products , the firm has to submit valid BIS/ISO/CE certificates.

- **x)** Scanned copy of List of Directors downloaded from the Ministry of company affairs website on the date of uploading the bid documents.
- **xi)** Authorization of a senior responsible Person of the company with an authority to transact business as per the provisions of Companies Act.
- xii) Performance statement giving the details of past performance of the bidder on the items quoted for last three years of 2015-16, 2016-17 and 2017-18. (The Supplies in the past performance shall be atleast 25% of the Tender quantity).
- **xiii)** Check list along with page number for each page.
- **xiv)** Audited Balance sheets of the last three financial years, 2015-16, 2016-17 and 2017-18 issued by Chartered Accountant.
- **xv)** Memorandum and Articles of Association of the company/ Copy of Registered Partnership deed of the firm duly attested by a Gazetted officer only.
- **xvi)** Self declaration of production capacity of each section for two months on single shift basis for each product. If the production capacity is lower than the requirement then the extra requirement shall be procured from other bid participants who has the production capacity if the L1 price is matched by the firm.
- **xvii)** Self declaration of Batch size for each quoted product.
- **xviii)** Copy of any document issued by State / Central Government towards proof as proprietor/managing Partner/Managing Director of the bidding firm duly attested by Gazetted Officer.

- **xix)** The details of GST ie number etc should be submitted in online
- **xx**) Declaration form with details of the firm contact no , email ID, and address should be submitted.
- **xxi)** Audited balance sheets of last three years 2015-16,2016-17,2017-18 should be submitted.
- **xxii)** 3 no of samples as per specifications along with test report shall reach physically to APMSIDC on or before 23.10.2019 5:00 p.m and cover should be super scribed with tender notice number, otherwise the tender will be rejected.

# 11) Time extension

- a) Tenders must be received on electronic platform not later than the time and date specified in the invitation for Tenders.
- **b)** The purchaser may at its discretion extend this deadline for submission of Tenders by amending the Tender document in which case all rights and obligations of the purchaser and tenderer previously subject to the original deadline will then be subject to be the new deadline.

#### THE TENDER DOCUMENT

#### CONTENT OF TENDER DOCUMENT

The goods required, tender procedures and contract terms are prescribed in the tender documents.

- A. Instructions to bidders.
- B. Conditions of Contract.
- C. Price Schedule (Model Tender Format)

# A) INSRUCTIONS TO TENDERER

- 1. The tenderer is expected to examine all the instructions, forms, terms and Specifications in the tender documents.
- 2. Failure to furnish all information specified in the tender documents, or submission of tenders not substantially responsible to the tender document in every respect will be at the Bidder's risk and may result in rejection of Tender.

Procedure for Evaluation of Tenders: - Evaluation of bids will be done in two stages:

- A) Technical Evaluation : Technical evaluation will be based on information furnished in the Technical bid document and the supporting documents. Technical evaluation will be done by Technical Evaluation Committee. To qualify in the Technical bids, a bidder has to satisfy all the conditions and furnish all supporting documents.
- **B) Financial Bid Evaluation**. Bids of the only those bidders who qualify in technical evaluation will be opened for evaluation of Financial bids. Financial bids will be evaluated based on prices of all inclusive prices quoted in the tender.

#### **3. PREPARATION OF TENDERS**

LANGUAGE OF THE TENDER :The tender prepared by the tenderer and all correspondence and documents relating to the tender exchanged by the tenderer and the purchaser, shall be written in English language, provided that any printed literature furnished by the tenderer may be written in another language so long as accompanied by an English translation of its pertinent passage in which case, for purpose of interpretation of tender, the English translation shall government.

# 4. PRICE SCHEDULE/FINANCIAL BID

The tenderer shall complete the Price schedule on e-procurement Platform and should submit online only.

#### **5. AWARD OF CONTRACT:**

The Purchaser reserves the right to accept or reject any tender, and to annulment the tender process and reject all tenders at any time prior to award of contract, without hereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders or any obligation to inform the affected bidder or bidders of the grounds for the purchaser's action.

The Managing Director, APMSIDC will be at liberty to terminate without assigning any reasons thereof the contract either wholly or in part on one month's notice. The tenderer will not be entitled for any compensation whatsoever in respect of such termination.

#### **6. NOTIFICATION OF AWARD**

The Tenders shall be valid up to 90 days from the last date of receipt of tenders. Prior to the expiration of the period of tender validity, the purchaser will notify the successful tenderer in writing by registered letter, that its tender has been accepted. In exceptional circumstances, the purchaser may solicit the Tenderers consent to an extension of the period of the validity and in such case the responses there to shall be made in writing. The EMD provided shall also be suitably extended. Tenderer may refuse the request without forfeiting the EMD.

#### 7. ENTERING INTO AGREEMENT

Within 10 days of the receipt of the acceptance letter, the successful tenderer shall enter into agreement on Rs.100/-(Rupees one hundred only) worth Non-Judicial Stamp Paper. The specimen form of agreement will be supplied by APMSIDC. Failure of the successful tenderer to enter into constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award, in which even the Purchaser may make the award to the next lowest evaluated tenderer or call for new tenders, duly forfeiting the E.M.D. The purchase order will be issued from time to time for a specific quantity during the course of Rate Contract Period. The supplier should supply the goods at the rate for which the Agreement is concluded for the purchase orders placed.

#### 8. CONDITIONS OF TENDER FOR THE SUPPLY OF SURGICAL CONSUMABLES TO APMSIDC UP TO A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS FROM THE DATE OF BID FINALIZATION.

**I.** APMSIDC reserves right to reject the tender of companies blacklisted by APMSIDC or any other State/National Organizations.

- **II** . The tenderer are requested to note that any taxes to be deducted at source at the rate fixed by the appropriate Govt. i.e. State / Central,
- **III.** The tenderer to whom supply contract is awarded shall not charge a higher price to APMSIDC than the price he quotes to any other Govt. organization or to a private Agency during the validity period of Rate Contract. If it is found that the firm has quoted a lower rate in another tender for another organization in the country and that it is not passing on the benefit of the lower rate to APMSIDC the differential amount will be deducted from the bills of the Firm. Such firms will be blacklisted for a period of 2 years.
- **IV**. The manufacturers who are awarded the supply contract are required to manufacture the Surgical consumables or products in their own units which are directly under the supervision of the board of Directors of the Company. Out sourcing of the supply from other units will not be permitted.

#### 9. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT :

9.1 : Every Tender should accompany an Earnest Money Deposit in the shape of Bank Guarantee or by online payment to the account of Managing Director, APMSIDC, Mangalagiri (Account No.142410011000314 IFSC Code: ANDB0000366) in any schedule bank and upload the original transaction slip with UTR number. Failure to pay the EMD and submitting the slip in the aforesaid manner will lead to the rejection of the bid. This E.M.D. is refundable to the unsuccessful tenderers.
9.2 : SSI firms located within the State of Andhra Pradesh (13Districts) holding Permanent Registration Certificate from the District Industries Centres of Department of Industries, Govt. of A.P. will be granted exemption from payment of Earnest Money Deposit.

#### **10. AGREEMENT**

Each successful Bidder is directed to execute an agreement by furnishing Performance security and a non judicial stamp paper of value of Rs. 100/- (Stamp duty to be paid by the bidder) to the Managing Director, APMSIDC, within 10 days from the date of receipt of intimation that his bid has been accepted. The specimen form of agreement will be supplied by the Managing Director, APMSIDC.

#### **11. PERFORMANCE SECURITY DEPOSIT**

**11.1** : The successful tenderer shall be required to pay a Performance Security Deposit of 5% of the contract value subject to a maximum of Rs.10 lakhs per product. The Performance Security Deposit should be paid in respect of each contract on or before the due date fixed, in the form of Bank Guarantee or Demand Draft drawn in favour of the Managing Director, Andhra Pradesh Medical Services & infrastructure Development Corporation, Mangalagiri, Guntur Dist.

**11.2** : The Security Deposit furnished by such tenderer in respect of his tender will be returned to him upon complete fulfillment of the tender period or the extended period if any to the satisfaction of the Managing Director, Andhra Pradesh Medical Services & infrastructure Development Corporation, Mangalagiri, Guntur Dist.

**11.3:** In the case of successful tenderers, the Earnest Money Deposit may, at the discretion of Managing Director, Andhra Pradesh Medical Services & infrastructure Development Corporation, Mangalagiri, Guntur Dist be adjusted towards the

Security Deposit payable by him. Unsuccessful tenderers EMD will be released after signing of the agreement by successful tenderer or after expiry of tender validity period.

# 12. QUANTITIES, PRICES AND OTHER CONDITIONS

**12.1** : The Quantity mentioned is only the probable requirement and may increase or decrease as per the decision of the Managing Director, APMSIDC. The rates should not vary with quantum of the order or the destination.

**12.2:** Imported Surgical consumables will be accepted with their original labels with which they were imported into India.

**12.3** : Rates inclusive of all duties and taxes should be quoted for each of the required Surgical consumables etc., separately on FOR basis, in metric system units according to the unit asked for, together with manufacturer name, license number under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 (Central Act 23 of 1940), Surgical consumables etc., offered. Tender for the supply of Surgical consumables with conditions and tender in which the rate is quoted for a unit other than the one asked for shall not be considered. No handling, clearing or transport charges etc will be paid. The deliveries should be made as stipulated in the purchase order placed with successful tenderers.

**12.4**: Bidder has to quote the price online only in the price schedule before 5.00PM on 22.10.2019.

**12.5** : The total unit price should be inclusive of all taxes, packing and forwarding FOR destination etc. All the bidders shall quote price for each as per specification given in the ESL list. If any firm is having the special packing , they can quote their price for their packing description and shall be mentioned in remarks column.

**12.6:** All rates quoted by the bidder should be valid for a period of two years from the date of acceptance of the lowest bid.

- **13.** The price quoted by the tenderer shall not in any case, exceed the controlled price, if any fixed by Central / State Government and the maximum retail price [MRP]. The APMSIDC at its discretion, will exercise, the right to revising the price at any stage so as to confirm to the controlled price or MRP as the case may be. This discretion will be exercised without prejudice any other action that may be taken against the tenderer.
- 14. If the Supplier/Rate Contract firm has not started the supply to the point of delivery as noted in the schedule noted above, the purchase orders will be cancelled and the corporation is at liberty to make alternative purchase of the items of medicines for which the purchase orders have been placed from any other sources or from the open market or from any other tenderer who might have quoted higher rates at the risk and the cost of the supplier and in such cases the corporation has every right to recover the cost and impose penalties as mentioned in other parts of this document. Apart from risk purchase action, the tenderer shall also suffer forfeiture of the Security Deposit.
- **15**. The rate quoted and accepted will be binding on the tenderer for the stipulated period and on no account will any variation in the price be entertained till the completion of this tender period.

- **16.1.**The value of the NSQ drugs will be deducted from the bills amount payable to the firm or from the performance security deposit of the firm.
- **16.2.** If the product is not consumed before its expiry date, the supplier should replace the short expiry/expired quantity with fresh stock of longer shelf life, otherwise the expired product will be returned to the supplier and the value equal to the cost of expired quantity will be deducted from the bills or any other amount payable to the firm.

#### 17. NOTE:

(a). No Tender shall be quoted for a product for which the company has been blacklisted either by A.P Rate Contract Committee or by any other state / Central Government organization.

**(b).** No Company which has been blacklisted either by AP Rate Contract Committee, APMSIDC or by any other State Government or Central Government Organizations shall participate in the bid during the period of blacklisting.

(c). No Tenderer shall be allowed at any time on any ground what so ever to claim revision of or Modification in the rates quoted by him. Clerical error, typographical etc., Committed by the bidders in the bid forms shall not be considered fter opening of the bids. Conditions such as "SUBJECT TO AVAILABILITY" "SUPPLIES WILL BE MADE AS AND WHEN SUPPLIES ARE RECEIVED" etc., will not be considered under any circumstances and the bids of those who have given such conditions shall be treated incomplete and for that reason, shall be summarily rejected.

(d). The Tenderer should supply the items at the rate quoted by him during the contract period. If at any time the price of bidded items is reduced by any law or Act of Central or State Government. Or by the Bidder himself, the payment will be made at reduced rate.

# 18. LOGOGRAMS:

Bids for the supply of surgical consumbales etc., shall be considered only if the bidder gives an undertaking in his bid that the supply will be prepared and packed with the logogram, as per the design enclosed in **Annexure- XIII**. All the surgical products have to be supplied in standard packing with different colour of PVC on one side and on other side with printed Drugs and cosmetics rules wherever it applies. Affixing of stickers and rubber stamps shall not be accepted. Bids of manufacturers who are not willing to agree to this condition will be summarily rejected. Failure to supply surgical consumables etc., with the logogram will be treated as breach of the terms of agreement and render the bidder liable for forfeiture of the EMD and security deposit, in addition to recovery of any attributable loss incurred by the Andhra Pradesh Medical Services & infrastructure Development Corporation.

**19.1**. The supplier shall provide such packing of the goods as is required to prevent

their damage or deterioration during transit to their final destination as indicated in

the contract. The packing shall be sufficient to withstand, without limitation, rough handling during transit and exposure to extreme temperatures, salt and precipitation during transit and open storage. Packing case size and weights shall take into consideration where appropriated the remoteness of the Goods final destination and the absence of heavy handling facilities at all points in transit.

**19.2** The packing, marking and documentation within and outside the packages shall comply strictly with such special requirements, as shall be provided for in the contract and subject to clause 18 and any subsequent instructions ordered by the purchaser.

Failure to comply with this shall lead to non-acceptance of the goods besides imposition of penalties.

**Note :-** If the supply is received in damaged condition in respect of primary packing, it shall not be accepted. In case of any acceptable deficiencies or damages in the secondary or tertiary packing, marking and documentation, the supply will be accepted only after levying penalties on the total value of supply to that destination. The penalties are Surgical consumables condition 2%, supplies in brand name 0.5%, non printing of AP GOVT logo 0.5%, MRP printing 0.5%).

#### **20. QUALITY TESTING:**

**20.1:** Samples of supplies in each batch will be chosen at the point of supply, distribution/ storage points for testing. The samples will be sent to Empanelled Laboratories/Government Laboratories.

**20.2:** The surgical consumables will be drawn periodically throughout the shelf life period.

**20.3:** The supplies will be deemed to be completed only upon receipt of the Quality certificates from the laboratories. Samples, which do not meet quality requirements, shall render the relevant batches liable to be rejected. If the samples do not conform to statutory standards, the bidder will be liable for relevant action under the existing laws. APMSIDC has the right to destroy such substandard goods.

**20.4:** The bidder should clearly understand that the decision of the Managing Director, Andhra Pradesh Medical Services & infrastructure Development Corporation or any officer authorized by him as to assess the quality of the supplied surgical consumables etc., shall be final and binding.

**20.5**: Each and every batch of products received from the firm will be subjected to quality test. As soon as the supply is made in the Central Drug Stores, the samples will be drawn by the quality control wing of APMSIDC and sent to the empanelled analytical testing laboratories for their quality testing as per pharmacopoeia and other standards.

**20.6**: Whenever a particular Surgical product is declared as "Not of Standard Quality" (NSQ) by the above laboratories in any parameter, another sample of same batch will be sent to DCA / CDL/NIB/NIMR /CDTL on the request of the firm at their cost for second opinion. In case the subject product is declared as NSQ in the second opinion, then the item of the firm will be blacklisted against the firm. The DCL/CDL declares the product as NSQ the item of the firm will be blacklisted.

**20.7:** The amount of the NSQ batch shall be deducted from the amount payable to the firm or from the performance security deposit of the firm. No purchase orders will be placed for the black listed item of the firm.

**20.8:** In case a firm is supplying more than one product and one of the products is declared as NSQ, in such case, in addition to the measure suggested above, 25% of total bill amount submitted by the firm will be withheld for a period of four months and will be paid after monitoring satisfactory supply of all other products.

**20.9:** If two items of any firm are black listed then the entire firm will be black listed and it will not be allowed to participate in tender for 3 consecutive years from the date of blacklisting.

20.11 The supplier shall furnish the evidence of the basis for expiration date and other stability data of the Surgical consumables on request by the Corporation.

# **21. ACCEPTANCE OF BIDS AND SUPPLY CONDITIONS**

**21.1:** The Managing Director, APMSIDC reserves the right to reject the bids or to accept the bids for the supply of all articles or for any one or more of the articles bided for in a bid without assigning any reason.

**21.2** : The Managing Director, APMSIDC will be at liberty to terminate without assigning any reasons thereof the contract either wholly or in part on one month's

notice. The bidder will not be entitled to any compensation whatsoever respect of such termination. The acceptance of the bids shall be communicated to the bidders in writing.

**21.3** : The supply should be started within 30 days and should be completed within 60 days. Supply shall be considered complete only upon receipt of at least 95% of the ordered quantity at each of the 13 District Warehouses and uploading of the required documents in e-Aushadhi software. The date of actual receipt of the goods or the date of uploading of the required documents whichever is later shall be considered as date of receipt of the material.

# 21.4 Penalty charges for delayed supply of drugs:

**1).** 60 days from the date of issue of PO. -- No penalty.

**2).** For the next 20 days i.e. 61st day to 80<sup>th</sup> day -- 0.5% per day of the value of drugs received during this period. The Purchase Order will be cancelled beyond 20 days from the stipulated period of supply of drugs, if the product has multiple bidders and if only single bidder is approved the Purchase Order will be cancelled beyond 30 days from the stipulated period of supply of drugs.

**3).** If more than one Purchase Order is not supplied in the stipulated period of supply then the firm will be declared as undependable supplier for the products for which the supplies are not executed.

**4).** If the bidder fails to execute the supply within the stipulated time, the APMSIDC is empowered to levy 10% penalty of the unexecuted value or differential cost incurred for the alternate purchase, whichever is higher.

**5).** The corporation will be at liberty to procure the drugs from L2 firm (or) Other lowest bidder and even from open market as situation demands and recover the extra cost from the L1 firm in case the bidder fails to surgical consumables supply (the rate difference between Rate Contract rate and Procured rate) from the amount payable or from the performance Security deposit of the Rate Contract holder.

21.5 : All the supplies will be scheduled for the period from the date of acceptance till the completion of the bid in instalments, as may be stipulated in the supply order.

**21.6**: It shall be the responsibility of the bidder for any shortages, damages at the time of receipt in the Central drug Stores and APMSIDC is not responsible for receipt of material for which no order is placed.

# 22.7 Inspection of the firms:

Whenever corporation feels that it is necessary to inspect the firm and its manufacturing facility either by MD or any person/committee nominated by MD, the bidder shall provide all data, documentation and information without cost. If any adverse report is received in such inspection, APMSIDC will issue show cause notice to the firm. If the reply is found not satisfactory, the APMSIDC shall have the right to reject the bid or terminate/ cancel the orders already issued or not to issue any further order. The tenderer, whose manufacturing unit is found to be not complying with GMP / WHO-GMP / ISO/BIS/CE during inspection, will be levied with a fine of Rs.1,00,000/- or the expenditure incurred by the APMSIDC in conducting such inspection whichever is higher. This fine amount shall be deducted from the EMD deposited by the bidder or from any other amount payable to them in any nature. The amount shall be deducted without any notice. In case of deficit, legal action will be taken against the bidder for recovery as per law.

# 22.Packing

**22.1** The supplier shall provide such packing of the goods as is required to prevent their damage or deterioration during transit to their final destination as indicated in the contract. The packing shall be sufficient to withstand, without limitation, rough handling during transit and exposure to extreme temperatures, salt and precipitation during transit and open storage. Packing case size and weights shall take into consideration where appropriated the remoteness of the Goods final destination and the absence of heavy handling facilities at all points in transit.

**22.2** The packing, marking and documentation within and outside the packages shall comply strictly with such special requirements, as shall be provided for in the contract and subject to clause 18 and any subsequent instructions ordered by the purchaser.

#### 23 Insurance

For the goods supplied at site, the insurance shall be obtained by the Supplier at his cost for an amount equal to 110% of the value of the goods from "warehouse to warehouse" on "All Risks" basis including war Risks and Strike clauses period in the joint names of purchaser and supplier.

#### 24 Incidental services.

The supplier is required to provide the all the incidental services as required and specified under the Technical Specifications, if any.

#### 25 Warranty

The Supplier warrants that all the Goods are new, unused, and of the most recent or current models, and that they incorporate all recent improvements in design and materials, unless provided otherwise in the Contract. The supplier further warrants that the goods supplied under this contract shall have no defect arising from design materials or workmanship (except insofar as the design or material is required by the purchasers specifications) or from any act or omission the supplied goods in conditions obtaining in the country of final destination.

The purchaser shall promptly notify the supplier in writing of any claims arising under this warranty.

#### 23. Force Majeure

- **23.1** Notwithstanding the provisions of clauses 22, 23, 24, the supplier shall not be liable for forfeiture of its performance security or liquidated damages or termination for default, if and to the extent that, its delay in performance or other failure to perform its obligations under the contract is the result of an event of Force Majeure.
- **23.2** For purposes of this clause "Force Majeure" means an event beyond the control of the supplier and not involving the suppliers fault or negligence and not fore-seeable. Such events may include but are not limited to, acts of the purchaser either in its sovereign or contractual capacity, wars or revolutions, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions and freight embargoes.
- 23.3 If a force majeure situation arises, the supplier shall promptly notify the purchaser in writing of such conditions with documentary evidence and the cause thereof. Unless otherwise directed by the purchaser in writing the supplier shall continue to perform its obligations under the contract as far as is reasonably practical and shall

seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the force majeure event.

#### 24. PAYMENT PROVISIONS:

A) No advance payments towards costs of Surgical consumables will be made to the bidder. However as far as possible payment will be made within 30 days after receipt of material at Central Drug stores.

B) Payments towards the supply of Surgical consumables Will be made strictly as per the rules of the APMSIDC.

C) No claims shall be allowed against the APMSIDC in respect of interest on Earnest Money Deposit or on Security Deposit or late payments.

D) In case of any enhancement in GST due to notification of the Government after the date of submission of tenders and during the tender period, the quantum of additional GST so levied will be allowed to be charged extra as a separate item without any change in price structure of the Surgical consumables approved under the tender.

E) Payments will be made after completion of 50% of supplies of order quantity and remaining will be paid after completion of 95% of supplies of order quantity at each of the 13 District warehouses.

# 25. PENALTIES :-

**25.1:** If the successful bidder fails to execute the agreement and / or deposit the required security within the time specified or withdraws his bid after the intimation of the acceptance of his bid has been sent to him or other reasons, he is unable to undertake the contract, his contract will be cancelled and the Earnest Money Deposit shall stand forfeited to the Andhra Pradesh Medical Services & Infrastructure Development Corporation and he will also be liable for all damages sustained by the Managing Director, Andhra Pradesh Medical Services & infrastructure Development Corporation, by reasons of breach, such as failure to supply / delayed supply, including the liability to pay any difference between the prices accepted by him and those ultimately paid for the procurement of the articles concerned. Such damages shall be accessed by the Managing Director, Andhra Pradesh Medical Services & Infrastructure Development Corporation by the Managing Director, Andhra Pradesh Medical Services for the procurement of the articles concerned. Such damages shall be accessed by the Managing Director, Andhra Pradesh Medical Services & Infrastructure Development Corporation whose decision is final in the matter.

**25.2**: If any articles or things supplied by the bidder have been partially or wholly used or consumed after supply and are subsequently found to be in bad order, unsound, inferior in quality or description or are otherwise faulty or unfit for consumption, then the contract price or prices of such articles or things will be recovered from the bidder, if payment had already been made to him. Otherwise the bidder will not be entitled to any payment whatsoever for such article. For infringement of the stipulations of the contract or for other justifiable reasons, the contract may be terminated by the Managing Director, Andhra Pradesh Medical Services & infrastructure Development Corporation and the bidder shall be liable for all the losses sustained by the Andhra Pradesh Medical Services & infrastructure Development Corporation in consequence of the termination which may be recovered personally from the bidder from his properties, as per rules.

**25.3:** In the event of supplies declared as NSQ, contract with the bidder will be suspended and further stocks for the pending PO's of the blacklisted product will not be accepted. The purchases will be made from alternative suppliers. Such Firm may be black listed for three (3) years beginning from the date of blacklisting. The bidder shall also be liable for action under criminal law and the matter shall be notified to the concerned Licensing authority of the Drugs Control Administration.

**25.4:** In all the above conditions, the decision of the Managing Director, Andhra Pradesh Medical Services & Infrastructure Development Corporation shall be final and binding.

**25.5:** In the event of any dispute arising out of the bids such dispute would be subject to the jurisdiction of the Civil Courts within the city of Mangalagiri.

# 26. SAVING CLAUSE:-

a.) No suit, prosecution or any legal proceedings shall lie against APMSIDC or any person for anything, which is done in good faith or intended to be done in pursuance of bid.

b) A supplier / firm whose products or the supplier/firm, itself have been blacklisted by the corporation which is displayed in the corporation website i.e. <a href="http://msidc.ap.nic.in">http://msidc.ap.nic.in</a> .

#### 27 Appeals :-

**27.1** A supplidder/firm who's product or the supplier/firm, itself have been blacklisted by the corporation which is displayed in the corporation website **i.e.://msidc.ap.nic.in//** may within 15 days from the date of display, may appeal to the Director General, Drug Control Administration, A.P.

The Director General, Drug Control Administration, A.P., after such enquiry into the matter, as is considered necessary and after giving the said supplier an opportunity for representing his views, may pass such order in relation thereto as he thinks fit.

**27.2** If the firm is not satisfied with the outcome may appeal within 15 days to the Principle Secretary, Health, Medical & Family Welfare, A.P. for review.

The State Government after such enquiry into the matter, as is considered necessary and after giving the said supplier an opportunity for representing his views, may pass such order in relation thereto as it thinks fit.

#### 28. Special Condition:-

(a) If any Company / Supplier quotes a lower rate to any other Agency / State in the country at a rate lower than the rate at which supplied to APMSIDC during the Rate Contract period, the differential amount is liable to be recovered. The Supplier/Company should furnish undertaking (Annexure II) that they will remit the differential cost if they quote and supply at a lower rate to any other Agency / State etc. in the country than the rate quoted or at which supplied to the Andhra Pradesh Medical Services & Infrastructure Development Corporation during the rate contract period.

(b).Substantiated supply of any part of whole consignment without meeting the quality specification shall also entail blacklisting of the firm for a minimum period of three years for that particular product apart from recovery of loss and such other action as provided for under the Drug and Cosmetics Act 1940 by rules 1945 and conditions of the tender document.

a) Purchase orders will be placed based on necessity and requirements only.

b) List of surgical consumables with specification are appended at **Annexure 1** while quoting the rates.

## **Technical Requirements**

T No.44(19-20)-Procurement of Surgical and Consumables

**1). Intellectual Property Rights:** The Supplier shall indemnify the APMSIDC against all third party claims of infringement of any patent, trademark, copyright or industrial design and other intellectual property rights arising from use of the surgical items supplied.

**2). Logograms:** Bids for the supply of surgical items shall be considered only if the Bidder gives an undertaking in his Bid that the supply will be prepared and packed with the logogram printed as per the design provided by the Corporation.

**3). Packaging:** The boxes shall be packed in weather resistant triple walled insulated 5-ply cartons. Each ply having strength of minimum 150 gsm. It should be fabricated from virgin quality 'A' grade material. The overall dimension of the carton should be such that the product does not get damaged during transportation and storage.

### 4). Quality Testing

**a)** Samples of surgical items supplied under the Contract will be subjected to quality tests. As soon as the material is received at Central Medicines Stores, the samples will be drawn by the Corporation staff. Each batch Samples shall be taken from each consignment and tested for quality in a time bound manner. APMSIDC may also draw samples from the peripheral units wherever the surgical items are supplied and get them tested in empanelled laboratories.

**b)** The Drug related surgical item samples will be sent to the Government approved and/or empanelled analytical testing laboratories for their quality as per Standards prescribed by the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and rules, 1945.

**c)** Whenever a particular item is declared as "Not of Standard Quality" (NSQ) or Sub-standard by the above laboratories then that item of the RC approved firm will be black listed against the firm.

d) All the NSQ products either drug related items or non-drug related items will not be returned to the company but will be destroyed, and the amount equivalent to the batch value will be deducted from the company bills. No purchase orders will be placed further.

i) In case of complaints, bills will be withheld till receipt of analytical report.
 Further action will be taken on the basis of report.

- ii) On physical verification by the District level inspection team, if any item is suspected to be of 'Not of Standard Quality', bills will be withheld until receipt of analysis reports as standard quality.
- iii) The decision of the Managing Director, APMSIDC, or any officer authorized by him as to the quality of the supplied Surgical consumables etc., shall be final and binding.
- **5.** The packaging and labeling standards for drug related items should comply with the related provisions of Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and rules thereof and also with requirements of Good Manufacturing Practices as per revised Schedule M of Drugs and Cosmetics rules,1945.
- **6.** The product must comply with general requirements of the item as the applicable standards of the country of the manufacture and in respect of drug related items as per the Indian Pharmacopeias (IP). In case the product is not included in I.P. but is official in B.P. or U.S.P. it should comply with requirements given in those pharmacopeias.
- 7. The packaging components should also conform to the specifications suitable for use in the prevailing climatic conditions. All the packaging should be properly sealed and tamper-proof. Pharmaceuticals requiring special storage requirements must specifically indicate on the label and containers and be shipped in special conditions to ensure the stability and the integrity of the surgical items.
- 8. Bar-coding requirements: Incorporation of barcodes (1D or 2 D) encoding unique product identification code (GTIN), Batch Number, Expiry Date and Serial Number of the Secondary pack on each of the secondary Level packaging and incorporation of barcodes (1 D or 2D) encoding unique product identification code (GTIN), Batch Number, Expiry Date and Serial Number of the Tertiary pack (shipper/carton) on each of the Tertiary Level packaging.

- No corrugated package should weight more than 15 kgs (i.e. Product + inner carton + corrugated box).

4) The corrugated boxes should be of narrow flute.

## JOINT:

5) Every box should be preferably single joint and not more than two joints.

**6)** Every box should be stitched using pairs of metal pins with an interval of two inches between each pair. The boxes should be stitched and not jointed using calico at the corners.

## FLAP:

- 8) Every box should be sealed with gum tape running along the top and lower opening.

## CARRY STRAP:

- 10) Every corrugated box should carry a large label clearly indicating that the product is for "A.P. Govt. Supply Not for Sale". The lower one third of the large label will indicate in bold the value of the product
- 11) The product label on the carton should be large at least 15 cm x 10 cm dimension. It should carry the correct technical name, strength or the product, date of manufacturing, date of expiry, quantity packed and net weight of the box.
